

How to Make a Fursuit Head

Materials

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| -mannequin head | -sharpie |
| -faux fur | -needle and thread |
| -upholstery foam | -various finishing materials |
| -balaclava | |
| -duct tape | |

This tutorial outlines how to make a static jaw fursuit head with the balaclava method.

Step 1) Start with a concept! It is easier to carve a head if you break it down into simple shapes.

Step 2) Using a pair of scissors, carve the shapes out of upholstery foam and then glue them to the balaclava.

Step 3) Cover the entire head with duct tape and draw the desired markings onto the duct tape to make a pattern.

Step 4) Carefully cut out the duct tape pattern and trace it onto the fur. Make sure you are paying attention to what direction the fur is supposed to go.

Step 5) Pin the furs onto the head to make sure everything fits nicely.

Step 6) Sew the pieces of the fur together to create a covering to go over the head.

Step 7) Slip the cover over the head and glue into place.

Step 8) Sew in the neck.

Step 9) Secure Eyes and nose and desired details such as eyelids, eyebrows, lips etc

Step 10) Fur the ears using the same process you did for the main part of the head.

Step 11) Airbrush if desired.

Step 12) Install the tongue and teeth
